Because of love of their timeless music, Felix Cavaliere and Gene Cornish, two legendary founders of The Rascals, are teaming up for the first time in five years. As members of the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame, Grammy Hall of Fame, Vocal Group Hall of Fame, and Songwriter Hall of Fame, The Rascals are widely considered the best 'blue-eyed soul' group to come out of the 1960s. 
Friday, September 28


